

Brandie Sutton, soprano

Soprano Brandie Sutton recently had a great personal success in the leading role of Rautendelein in New York City Opera's very successful production of Respighi's rarely-performed opera "*La Comparsa Sommersa*". Her performance was received with unanimous acclaim, both by critics and audiences.

Hailed by The New York Times for her "warm, ample voice", and "distinctive earthy coloring", and by Opera News for "her sumptuous mid-weight soprano", Ms. Sutton has performed with the National Symphony Orchestra, Radio Orpheus Symphony Orchestra in Moscow, the Krasnoyarsk Philharmonic Symphony Orchestra, The Royal Danish Orchestra, Flint Symphony Orchestra, and the Jazz at Lincoln Center Orchestra.

She has won several awards and competitions, including most recently, Harlem Opera Theater Ms. Sutton has sung leading roles at the Palacio de Bellas Artes, the Grand Theatre de Geneve, Hamburgische Staatsoper, Semperoper, Dresden, AlterOper, Frankfurt, Teatro Petruzelli, Bari, New York City Opera, and was a featured artist at Carnegie Hall.

In Summer 2017, she will make her Lincoln Center debut in the opening concerts of the Mostly Mozart Festival.
